The floor was open for public comment at 9:32 p.m. and immediately closed with no residents' present.

All Bills on hand were paid.

The board reviewed recent correspondence from Frontier Communications regarding a claim on Orwell Twp. This will be passed onto Attorney Alan Shaw as this matter is already in his hands.

Milt Robinson volunteered to contact Mr. Shaw to touch base about the Dustin Pedro case hearing and review all other matters.

Milt presented the Manchester Rd. agreement for the dirt and gravel road project to be filed.

Milt Robinson made a motion to have the road crew resume work on Monday, May 4th following the states Covid19 guidelines with social distancing and cleanliness. Chad Cooley seconded this motion and the motion passed.

After reviewing, Milt Robinson made a motion to have the extra dust oil ad run twice in the Daily Review and the Rocket Courier, to be due by May 22nd. Chad Cooley seconded this motion, John Strobe made it unanimous, and the motion passed.

The board briefly discussed trying hot mix on some bridge and driveway approaches before chipping begins.

After discovering a missing whirly bird from the roof, the board decided to act on getting spray foam estimates and/or replacing the whirly bird to help with the condensation issue in the outer building. This matter is ongoing.
