

June 17th, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. the Board of Supervisors of Orwell Township met at the Orwell Township building for their regular monthly meeting. All members were present.

The floor was open for public comment at 6:35 p.m. and immediately closed with no residents' present.

The minutes of the last regular monthly meeting were read. Milt Robinson made a motion to accept the minutes with one minor change, Chad Cooley seconded the motion, and John Strope made it unanimous. The minutes were approved with one minor change. The Treasurer's Report was reviewed. Chad Cooley made a motion to accept it as written, John Strope seconded the motion and Milt Robinson made it unanimous. The Treasurer's Report was approved as written.

#### Road Report:

Mowed and cut brush back

Cleaned ditches on Potterville Street and Haigh's Pond Rd.

Filled bad spots with cold patch

Clear, load, and haled ditch dirt from Ridge Rd.

Water and Oiled Rds.

Finished grading roads

Installed new pipe on Morris Road

Installed a field pipe for Adam Russell

Installed a new started in the F550

Put 2 new front tires on the grader

GMC Truck got inspected

Mowed Cragle Cemetery

Received 800 ton of 1B from S. Andrulonis for Chipping

Purchased a 6 by 8 Squash Pipe from Fry's plastic

All Bills on hand were paid.

Milt Robinson made a motion to donate \$500.00 to the North Orwell Hall of Trustees. Chad Cooley seconded that motion, John Strope made it unanimous and the motion passed.

The CDL paperwork required by the state was reviewed and approved along with the road crew's driving records.

**Resolution 2020-3** was signed regarding the Hazardous Mitigation Plan.

The board briefly discussed HB 1813 after the PA Community Rights Network had reached out looking for support. They agreed more details were needed on the bill before responding to this.

The Manchester Rd. Dirt and Gravel Road Project is moving forward by finding tree removal quotes.

Palmatier Enterprises is set up to come in a few months to do the spray foam job in the ceiling of the outer building.

Suit Kote is scheduled to come in the morning to do seal coating.

Throughout the month, it was decided to get a quote on fixing the F550. This matter is pending.

From the road and pipe review, Morris Rd. pipe seems in good condition but Wolfe Rd. needs some work. A lot of the water damage on Wolfe Rd. is being caused from the water running from the gas well pad driveway. Milt volunteered to contact Repsol to inquire about this issue.

Our municipal rep from Penn Dot performed a survey of the current road conditions in our township throughout the month. He found that he needs to subtract half a mile of roads to be reported to Harrisburg due to Harrison Rd. being blocked off and Raes Way Rd. being closed.
