

July 16th, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. the Board of Supervisors of Orwell Township met at the Orwell Township building for their regular monthly meeting. John Strope and Milt Robinson were present.

The floor was open for public comment at 6:35 p.m. and immediately closed with no residents' present.

The minutes of the last regular monthly meeting were read. Milt Robinson made a motion to accept the minutes as written, John Strope seconded the motion, and the minutes were approved as written. The Treasurer's Report was reviewed. Milt Robinson made a motion to accept it as written, John Strope seconded the motion and the Treasurer's Report was approved as written.

Road Report:

Installed a 6 x 9 x 30 squash pipe and headwalls on Lovett Hill Rd.

Installed a 48 x 40 black plastic and headwalls on Dehaan Rd.

Fill ditches in with R4s on Wolf Hill Rd. then graded

Loaded and Hauled creek debris from Cemetery Rd.

Hauled creek gravel to Gary Hennip's old barn foundation on 187

Dropped off the 07' to Todd Miller at Cranes Truck Garage in Greenslanding for an axle seal replacement

Took the 14' to Wolfes Garage for a def light

Called Service Tire for a flat tire on the backhoe

AC not working in the Western Star

Rented an excavator for a pipe replacement

Rented a bulldozer to push gravel

All Bills on hand were paid.

The board reviewed 3 quotes for tree removal. Milt Robinson made a motion to accept Endless Mountains Logging LLC tree clearing and chipping quote for the Manchester Rd. dirt and gravel project for \$5,199.84. John Strope seconded that motion and the motion passed.

Seal Coating was done throughout the month and complete.

Rd. Crew had frontier lines get pulled into the boom mower on East Cook Rd.

Numerous signs are coming up missing on N. Orwell Rd., and intersections on Claire Rd., Herrickville Rd., Crawford Rd., Tabernacle Rd., and Rockwell Rd.

After speaking with our Penn Dot rep., it was determined that Orwell Township consists of 1.95 miles of turnback road and 44.43 of dirt road, totaling 46.38 totals miles in the township.

The board briefly discussed moving some Impact Fee Money over into the Capitol Reserve account but decided to wait until next month to review the account totals.

Repsol agreed to work on there driveway to help alleviate some of the water damage to Wolfe Rd. This matter is ongoing.
