Replacement road signs arrived

All Bills on hand were paid.

Resolution 2020-5 was passed to transfer \$21,000.00 into the Capitol Reserve Fund.

Milt Robinson made a motion to approved the 2021 proposed budget. John Strobe seconded it, Chad Cooley made it unanimous, and the motion passed.

Resolution 2020-6 was signed, accepting the 2021 budget.

Attorney Alan Shaw's contract was signed making him our 2021 township solicitor.

The agreement was signed regarding the pension plan. The pension plan will go into effect January 1st of 2021.

Subdivision paperwork was reviewed and signed for Moyer and Ronald Brown.

Kyle Snyder inquired about purchasing antiskid from the township or storage at the township building for his personal antiskid. The board found both scenarios to be unfeasible due to liability and insurance concerns.

Milt made a motion to make a onetime donation to the LeRaysville Pike Fire Dept. in the amount of \$500.00. Chad Cooley seconded this motion and John Strobe made it unanimous. The motion passed.
