The minutes of the last regular monthly meeting were read. Chad Cooley made a motion to accept the minutes with one minor change. Jeff Robbins seconded the motion and the minutes were approved with one minor change. The minutes of the reorganizational meeting were read and Chad Cooley made a motion to accept them as written. John Strobe seconded the motion, Jeff Robbins made it unanimous and the minutes were approved as written. The Treasurer's Report was reviewed. John Strobe made a motion to accept it as written, Jeff Robbins seconded it, and the treasurer's report was approved as written.

The 2021 township accounts were audited throughout the month. All bookwork was in order, reconciled, and well organized.

Chad Cooley seconded this motion, John Strobe made it unanimous, and the motion passed.
