Purchased a pole saw from Rovendales and plow blade edges from Bradco
New tires on GMC and 1 new tire on the 14' freightliner
Repaired the plow frame on the Western Star
Repaired the tire Chains

Mr. Jones agreed to continue providing his services as our township solicitor. The 2025 solicitor contract was signed.
