The floor was open for public comment at 7:05 p.m. and immediately closed with no resident's present.

Road Report:

Replaced culvert pipes and headwalls

Clean debris and push trees back from road edge

Rocked Cook Rd. outlet with 2 loads of R7

Cold Patched holes in tar and chip

Grade and rolled roads

Put down 4300 gallons of Dust Control

Straightened up numerous road signs

Changed breaks and rotors on Front of GMC

Installed a spray system in the 2007 Freightliner

The CAT Roller has seized up numerous times while operating and needs to be reset to continue rolling.

Hauled 2 loads of tires to landfill from township clean up, roughly 4 tons in total

All Bills on hand were paid.

Subdivision paperwork was approved and signed for John & Michele Vough.

Correspondence from the Sanitation Committee was received throughout the month regarding numerous complaints to Casey McPherson's property in Potterville which houses two apartments and one pizza shop. This matter is ongoing.

After reviewing a quote, Milt Robinson made a motion to purchase forks for our 938G Caterpillar for \$3,450.00. Chad Cooley seconded this motion, John Strobe made it unanimous, and the motion passed.

The board reviewed bids from Gary Kaszowski, James Perkins, Richard Daum, and Mike Veneziano for the advertised F550 plow truck. Milt Robinson made a motion to reject all bids. Chad Cooley seconded this motion, John Strobe made it unanimous, and the motion passed.

Extra dust oil requested from residents has been complete.

John Strobe presented the grader service package information and a JD Link quote from 5 Star Equipment to the board. The board agreed to table the service package until August.

Chad Cooley made a motion to put the grader back online with JD LINK through 5 Star Equipment. Milt Robinson seconded this motion and the motion passed.
