Milt Robinson made a motion to sell the F550 truck to Gary Kaszowski for \$6,000.00 as one piece. Chad Cooley seconded it and John Strobe made it unanimous.

Correspondence was received regarding Curt Ferris, our EMC being out of compliance. This will be looked into.

The board was made aware that the Potterville store property was given an immediate solution and a long-term solution to abate the problem at hand with their sewer. This matter will be ongoing for quite sometime to take the necessary steps.

Bradford County Conservation District released the Dirt and Gravel Rd. Project rankings where as Hall Road was ranked #2 and Dehaan Rd. was ranked 18th, 30th, and 33rd for three different categories.

The forks purchased from Cleveland Brothers didn't work with our bucket and will be sent back. The board agreed to continue looking for a set that will attach correctly.

More Frontier phone lines were found laying along the roads throughout the month. This matter has been taken care of to continue road side mowing.

Milt Robinson made a motion to hire Baker Power Washing for his quoted price of \$1,824.00 to pressure wash the township building. Chad Cooley seconded this motion, John Strobe made it unanimous, and the motion passed.
