Road Report:

Plugged 2 back tires of the GMC to replace nails

All cinders and 1b are in building and covered for winter maintenance, 1700 ton in total.

All Bills on hand were paid.

Subdivision paperwork was reviewed and approved for Brian Chaffee and Angela Strickland.

Beaver Valley Cable contacted Orwell Township in regards to applying for a grant that will broaden their coverage area and also request funding if available. The board agreed there isn't sufficient funding at this time to contribute to this project.

The sale of F550 fell through, throughout the month. Milt Robinson made a motion to re-run the ad to sell the F550 "as is" for \$4500.00 or more, making all bids due by the following meeting on Oct. 20th. Chad Cooley seconded this motion, John Strope made it unanimous, and the motion passed.
