

May 20th 2026 at 7:00 p.m., the Board of Supervisors of Orwell Township met at the Orwell Township building for their regular monthly meeting with all members present.

The floor was then open for public comment at 7:01 p.m. with a representative from S. Andrulonis Enterprises LLC present for the bidding process. Public comment time was then immediately closed with no comments.

Stone bids were then opened from Wysox Sand and Gravel, Lopke, and Andrulonis. Oil and equipment bids were opened from Midland Asphalt, Vestal Asphalt, and Suit-Kote. Chad Cooley made a motion to accept the stone bid from S. Andrulonis Enterprises LLC for \$35.48 a ton, 500 tons of Penn Dot approved, washed #8, less than 1% and \$36.74 a ton of 400 tons of Penn Dot Approved, washed #67, less than 1%. Jeff Robbins seconded this motion, John Strope made it unanimous, and the motions passed. John Strope made a motion to accept Suit-Kote's bid for oil at Costars price and tar and chipping equipment rental totaling \$17,050.00 for each 8-hour day. Jeff Robbins seconded that motion, Chad Cooley made it unanimous, and the motion passed.

The minutes of the last regular monthly meeting were read. Chad Cooley made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Jeff Robbins seconded the motion, John Strope made it unanimous, and the minutes were approved as written. The treasures report was reviewed. Jeff Robbins made a motion to accept it, John Strope seconded it, Chad Cooley made it unanimous, and the treasurer's report was approved.

Road Report:

- Swept tar and chipped roads
- Added material to Lovett Hill
- Took spreaders and plows off
- Cleaned ditches around Wyt's house
- Graded, raked, and rolled throughout the month
- Replaced a bad roller sensor
- Picked up new grader blades
- Took 14' to M.R. Garage for exhaust manifold

All bills on hand were paid.

The board approved the use of township roads for Herrickville Wesleyan church to host a 5K race on July 4th. A letter will be sent with our approval.

The South Hill Road project is still pending at this time, waiting to hear back from the Conservation District.

The board continued to discuss Claire Rd. and all available options. John Strope will be discussing some sizing questions from an engineer in the month ahead to move forward with this project.
